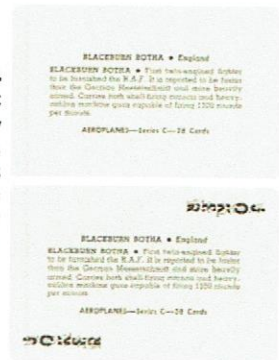

Note: There appears to have been four printings during the run of these cards. The key is the four different Republic P-47 "Thunderbolt" cards: (1) "REPUBLIC P-47" (Type 1 "Plain" back). A silver colored aircraft in a shallow starboard dive. The aircraft appears to actually be a Republic P-43 "Lancer"; (2) "REPUBLIC P-47" (Type 2 "Gum" back). The P-47 is in a light brown camouflage scheme in a shallow portside banking climb; (3) The same P-47 artwork with the REPUBLIC P-47 "Thunderbolt" caption (Type 1 "Plain" back); and (4) The same P-47 card #3 with the Type 2 or "Gum" back. The text backs of the four P-47 cards are identical except for the "Plain" and "Gum" back variations. There is no way to differentiate which printing the non P-47 cards are associated with. The collecting of this set therefore becomes rather straightforward (a) collect the four different Republic P 47 "Thunderbolt" cards, and (b) collect a "Type 1" and a "Type 2" card for each of the remaining 26 cards.

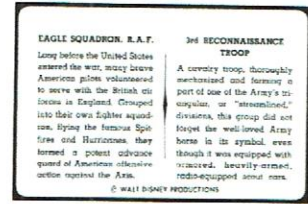

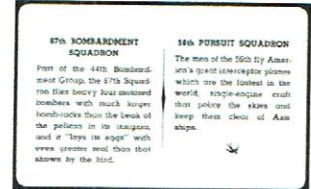
