2. Type 2. Thin card. Size 63 x 38 m/m. Front in sepia. Three styles: (i) Back printed vertically in blue, inscribed at base "Giles Lith. Co. New York & Boston". Front with "Old Judge" in quotation marks. About 20 unnamed Actresses known, and one Fighter—"Jem Smith" as illustrated at Fig. X2/167-2.

(ii) Back printed horizontally in blue, inscribed at base "Major, Knapp & Co., Park Pl., N.Y.". "Old Judge" on front without quotation marks. Two known, probably both connected with prizefighting—(1) Gen'l Butler, (2) Powderly.

(iii) Back printed horizontally in black, inscribed "Old Judge Cigarettes—Goodwin & Co., New York—Copied from Photo by Wood, 208 Bowery, N.Y.". Two known, both Baseball Players—(1) R. F. Dor-gan, N.Y.'s, (2) L. F. Richardson, N.Y.'s.

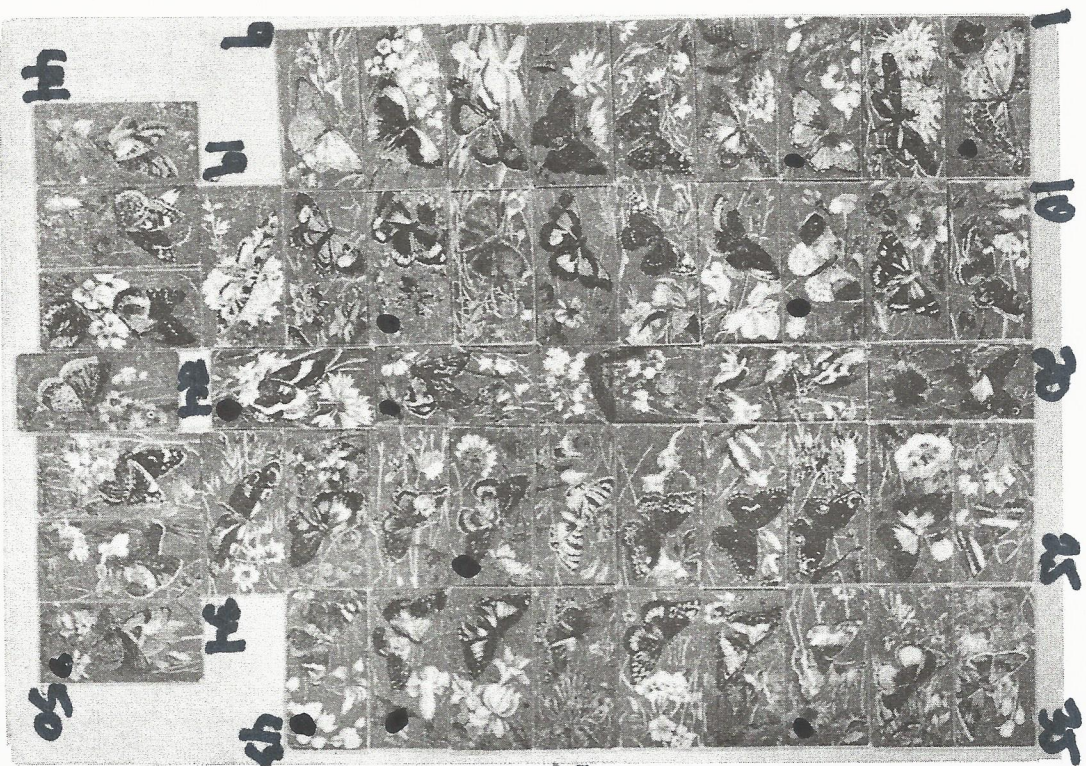
